



## Additional information on how to claim reimbursement/support for publication fees

### A: Researchers applying to a central fund at a university or institute:

If you work at a university or institute that maintains a central fund to cover publication fees for Open Access publication you yourself will have to apply to the university or institute by following their guidelines. You can find relevant websites [here](#) which will guide you to the right contact point. Below we list typical information that you may be asked to provide when you apply:

When posted online, articles will be assigned a DOI number whereby it becomes possible to search and cite them without delay.

### B: Researchers with support from a funding body that supports Open Access

If the research on which your article is based has been financed by a private or public funder that has an Open Access fund, you can apply directly to the funder (see list [here](#)). You may be asked for similar information as that listed in the section above. You may already have budgeted for the publication fee when applying for the research grant in which case the publication fee has already been identified.
